The 64th California State Convention is a weekend square dance convention sponsored by the California Council of Square Dancers, Inc. While this event is open to the public, the primary attendees will be square and round dancers from throughout California, Oregon and Nevada, who are there to participate in the “learned” square dance program. We anticipate approximately 400 people will attend this 3-day event, including many who camp in RVs on the fairgrounds.

Rental fee for your first 10’ x 20’ booth is \$40.00; Each additional 10’ x 20’ booth is \$30. Each booth space comes with one 8’ undraped table and two chairs, plus registration for one staff member. Additional equipment (tables & chairs) or registrations can be requested below.

Full payment must accompany your Vendor Application Form. Payment for any last-minute booth reservations/additions will be required prior to commencement of your booth set-up.

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VENDOR INFORMATION

**DATES:** April 10, 11, 12, 2026

**LOCATION:** Santa Maria Fairpark, 937 So. Thornburg, Santa Maria, California

**CONDITIONS:** This is a square dance weekend for dancers of all ages, including youth. Many of our dancers will be staying in their RVs on the Fairgrounds.

**DANCE SCHEDULE/HOURS:** Friday, April 10, 2026 - 7:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m.; Saturday, April 11, 2026 - 9:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. & 6:30 p.m. to 10:00 p.m.; Sunday, April 12, 2026 - 9:00 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. The vendor hall will be closed on Saturday from 4:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. for a dinner break. The hall will be re-opened at 6:00 p.m. for pre-dance shopping and set-up for the Welcome Ceremonies. The vendor hall will not be available on Sunday, April 12 as dancing will be held in a different building.

**SET-UP:** The Fairgrounds will be available for set-up starting at 10:00 a.m. on Friday, April 10, 2026. Vendors are welcome to open for business beginning at 3:00 p.m. on Friday, however vendors are not required to be open until 6:00 p.m. on Friday.

**TEAR-DOWN:** No vendor is allowed to tear-down until after 9:30 p.m. on Saturday, April 11, 2026 (*please pack very quietly while dancing is in session*). The building will close at 11:00 pm on Saturday. Load-out must be complete by 12:00 p.m. on Sunday, April 12, 2026. (There will be no dancing in the hall on Sunday).

**RENTAL FEES:** Rental fee for your first booth is **\$40.00**; additional booths are priced at **\$30.00 each**. Payment of the full rental agreement must accompany your booth application. Payment for last-minute booth reservation/additional booth requests must be paid prior to commencement of your booth set-up. Each vendor is limited is three (3) spaces.

**RV PARKING/FOOD:** There is RV parking available on the fairgrounds. Dry camping will be \$35/night with no utilities; partial hookups will be \$45/night (includes limited power and access to dump station.) Reservations for RV Parking at the Fairpark will open on October 8, 2025; register through the link that will be added to the website on that date. Space to park your stock/equipment trailers (no camping) will be made available at no charge. There are currently no food concession stands available at the Fairpark but we are hoping to bring in local food trucks for the event.
